ACCESSIBLE CAMPING INFORMATION

To register for accessible facilities at the Festival you will need to complete this Registration Form and forward the completed form to the Woodford Folk Festival at the addresses on the form. ***Please note: You may not be able to utilise to our accessible facilities if you do not register prior to the Festival. We ask that you submit your forms prior to the 18th December so that we can best cater to your needs.***

Please check in with the Access Support Manager or one of the Happy Campers when you arrive so they can direct you to your site.

General Information

The Woodford Folk Festival Accessible Camping area is located close to the Festival Village entrance. The Accessible Camping Office is also right near by, where our team can answer any questions or provide any help you may need.

You may also choose to stay in Tent City. Please visit www.tentcityhire.com.au for information and pricing. It is located a little further away from the other accessible area but is still in a convenient location.

Facilities

- Electricity (available for life support equipment only, please see below for requirements)
- First Aid and Emergency services located nearby
- Close access to the General Store
- Shuttle bus transport to the Fire Event on 1st January
- Childminding service at The Land Of Nod (fees involved)

Electricity (for approved life support equipment)

- No power will be supplied to any tent
 - ALL extension leads need to be tested and tagged
 - All Caravans/RVs/Motorhomes need to have a current electrical safety certificate
- Failure to comply with any of the above conditions will result in no electrical supply to your camp.

Arrival procedures

When you arrive at the Festival for the first time, proceed through the main Festival gate Drive-Thru to receive your Festival wristband in exchange for your *e-ticket*. If you have registered with us for accessible camping prior to the festival then, whether you are staying one night or eight, you will be able to camp in the Accessible Camping area within the Season Camping grounds. Follow the signs or ask our friendly traffic attendants to guide you to the Accessible Camp Manager's office to register your arrival. We will then direct you to your camping site and help you settle in. **Gates open for Season Camping ticket holders from 6.30am on 26th December. If you hold a Christmas Day Camping Ticket (available for purchase at an additional fee) then you can arrive from 2pm 25th December.** Please ensure your Accessible Vehicle Pass is displayed and if you don't already have one prior to arriving, stop by the Solutions Tent before heading to the campground.
